Today, we celebrate the Baptism of the Lord. Gospels from Luke 3:15-16,21-22. This coming Sunday we celebrate the second of three key moments in which Jesus is revealed. The first was last week's Epiphany with the visit of the Magi, and this week we jump ahead some 30 years to Jesus' Baptism. This scene takes place at the Jordan River. The reading opens by letting us know the emotional state of the crowd there: They are filled with expectation and wonder if John might be the Christ. Christ is the Greek word for Messiah, the title of the savior the Jews have been waiting for. Clearly John as made an impression, and he makes it clear that the Messiah is much greater than himself. In fact, the Messiah would baptize with the Holy Spirit and fire instead or water. After the Baptism, Jesus is revealed as being more than a mere human. Prayer: Dear Holy Trinity, thank you for loving us so much that you reveal yourselves to us as Persons we can know. Help us to embrace the relationship with each of you that we received when we were baptized. Let our love for you grow so that we may live more deeply our baptismal promises. Amen In your name we pray...Amen
