This week's Gospel is what immediately follows, with the opening verse repeating last week's final verse. It begins with their initial skepticism. They ask, "Isn't this the son of Joseph?" The people know Jesus' father is an everyday carpenter, not a priest, prophet or rabbi. Why should Jesus be applying Isaiah's prophecy about being the messenger of good things to himself? **Prayer: Dear Jesus, you remind us that you came to save everyone. Help us to always be open to what you are doing., even if we are surprised by whom you are helping. May we lay down our pride and lead all people to your love. In your name we pray...Amen**
