The Fresno Diocese is collecting signatures to oppose Senate Bill 24, a bill that would mandate all public university campus to distribute RU-486 abortion drugs from student health centers. These abortion drugs are used to end a pregnancy and take an unborn human life up to 10 weeks old: at this stage, the baby has a heartbeat, brain activity, facial features, and all major organs. The student takes the first pill in the student clinic, but the last set of pills are taken at home or in her shared dorm bathroom with no supervision; and as noted by the FDA, thousands of women have been hospitalized and 24 women have died because of these drugs.

Our tax dollars will likely be used to fund the program, and the UC and CSU university systems have stated that they will need to use student fees as well. Even pro-choice governor, Jerry Brown, vetoed this poor legislation last year. But with a new governor this year, we need your help to send a strong message to the Capitol that we do not want these abortion drugs on our campuses. This summer, the anti-Catholic/anti-Confession bill, SB-360, was dropped after Catholics & more sent in over 100,000 petitions to the capitol. We need you to do the same to help defeat this bill for a second time. We will be collecting signatures after Masses today- you do not need to be a registered voter, but you do need to be 18 or older and a California resident. Please fill out ALL portions, as the petition will not be valid without this information. Please pray that this bill will not pass, as it would even set an example for other states to follow.
