ANOINTING OF THE SICK

"Is anyone sick among you? Let them call for the elders of the church, and they should pray over the sick and anoint them with oil in the name of the Lord. This prayer made in faith will save the sick, and if they have committed any sins, they will be forgiven."

- Letter of James 5:14-15.

This New Testament passage is the basis for our Sacrament of the **Anointing of the Sick**. It is intended to be a prayer of the community for healing and forgiveness. For some centuries, it came to be seen as "last rites" only for those near death. In recent years, its original meaning has been appreciated once again. Anyone who is seriously ill, made infirm by age or is about to undergo surgery may request this sacrament. For those near death, the true "last rites" is the *Viaticum*, literally "food for the journey": the Holy Eucharist given to those near death to nourish them for eternal life. Please remember to advise the Parish office whenever the sacrament is needed for a loved one or friend.

NOVEMBER: a time to Remember the Faithful Departed

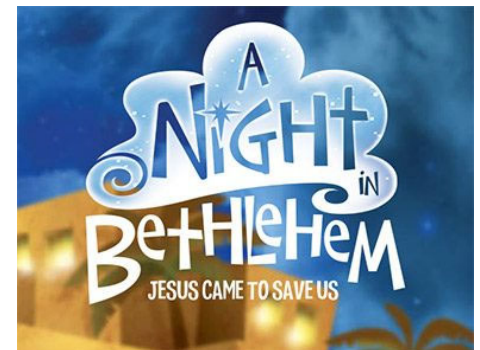
