

Receiving the Sacraments

Anointing of the Sick: This Sacrament of Healing is available to baptized Catholics who are seriously ill, facing major surgery or near death. Call the Parish Office to schedule.

Confession: Confessions are held every Friday in the New Church starting at 5pm. You may also call the parish office to schedule an individual confession with Father.




July Dedicated to The Precious Blood of Jesus

The precious blood of Jesus. Officially established by Pope Pius IX in 1849 but the devotion itself dates back to the beginning of Christianity. This month we take a moment to reflect on the Precious Blood of Jesus. The Precious blood refers specifically to the blood shed from Jesus on the cross as well as his blood that we receive in the wine during communion.

On the note of receiving wine during communion, it is of upmost importance that we show reverence for the blood as well as the body of our Lord. According to the USCCB this is the appropriate way.

When receiving Holy Communion, the communicant bows his or her head before the Sacrament as a gesture of reverence and receives the Body of the Lord from the minister. The consecrated host may be received either on the tongue or in the hand, at the discretion of each communicant. When Holy Communion is received under both kinds, the sign of reverence is also made before receiving the Precious Blood.

Remember that we never take communion, we receive it. Communion is a gift from God, we have done nothing, nor can we ever do anything to be worthy of it. Keep this in your heart as you approach the Lord.

This Week's Featured Feast Day

Saint Maria Goretti

A.D. 1890–1902

Feast Day: July 6th



Saint Maria Goretti proved forgiveness was possible in any situation. She proved forgiveness transforms the world. Maria was born into a poor family in Italy. Her father had died when she was nine, and they could not afford their own home, so they shared a house with the Serinelli family.

On July 5, 1902, Alessandro Serenelli (a 20-year-old man who lived in the house) attacked Maria with the intention to rape her. She refused, and he threatened to kill her. According to testimony, she fought him and screamed, "No! It is a sin! God does not want it!" Then, Serenelli stabbed her.

Her mother found her on the floor and took her to the nearest hospital. Maria went into emergency surgery, but it became clear that she wasn't going to make it. She woke up during the surgery and one of the doctors said to her, "Maria, think of me in Paradise." Maria answered him, "I will gladly think of you." From her hospital bed, she prayed that her mother would be all right. And then she did the unthinkable: She forgave Serenelli, her murderer. "For the love of Jesus, I forgive him, and I want him to be with me in Paradise."

And then, Saint Maria Goretti passed into Paradise. Serenelli would have received life in prison, but since he was not yet 21, he was sentenced to 30 years. He was bitter and not sorry for his actions—until one day. It was 11 years into his jail term, and all of a sudden, he had a vision of a garden. There was a young girl playing in it, dressed in white. He realized it was Maria. She brought him lilies, but he didn't want to take them. Maria urged him to take them, and finally he did. When he took each lily, it transformed into a white flame. Maria repeated her forgiveness for him and then disappeared.

Serenelli's life changed that day. He repented, turned back to God, and became a model prisoner. After he finished his jail term, he went to the house of Maria's mother and begged her forgiveness. She told him that if Maria had forgiven him, then she had to forgive him too. And so, she did. Serenelli went on to become a Franciscan lay brother. He was present when Pope Pius XII canonized Maria as a saint.

Forgiveness transforms lives. Forgiveness transforms the world. Your capacity for forgiveness is greater than you know.
