Once we have volunteers scheduled to help, we will begin this fun and important ministry.



The Importance of Good Classroom Behavior

We are so lucky to have such amazing teachers who volunteer their time and give of their talents for the children of our

parish. The children are being introduced to Miss Annie's 3 Strikes Rule this week (some last week). I like to give the kids scenarios of good decisions and bad decisions, i.e. talking in class, hitting someone, helping someone. They are aware that they know the difference between good behavior and bad behavior. I will then explain my 3 Strikes Rule.

- Should a child be disruptive and sent to my office, they will receive their **1st Strike** and will sit the remainder of the class with me. I will also send notice of this to the parent.
- Should a child once again be sent to my office for being disruptive during class, they will receive their **2nd Strike**. Parents will be called to come and pick up their child early.
- Should a child be sent to my office for a third time, this will be their **3rd Strike**. They have shown that they are not willing to listen and participate

in the class in a respectful manner. At this point, we will call for parent pick up and the student will not return to classes for the remainder of the season.

We NEVER want things to come to this but have to do what is best for the whole class.
