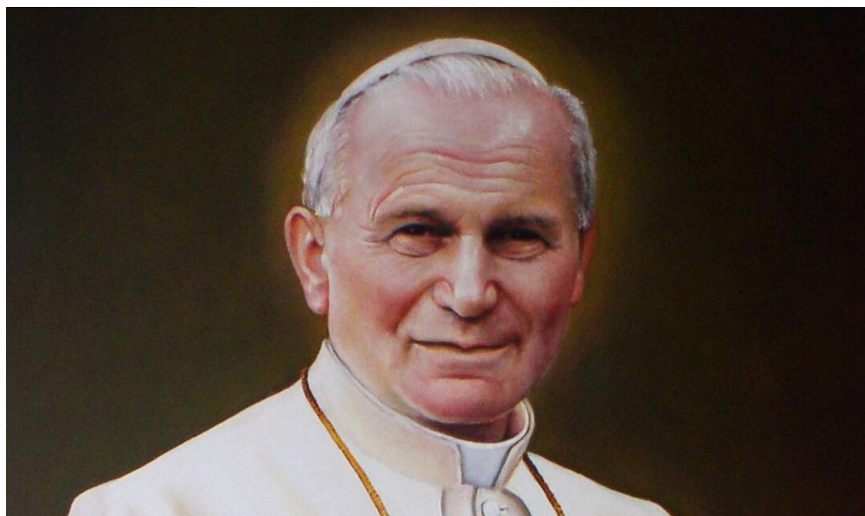

This Week's Featured Feast Day



St. John Paul, II

Feast Day: **October 22nd**

The Catholic Church celebrates the Feast Day of **St. John Paul II** on **October 22**, honoring one of the most beloved and influential popes in modern history. Born **Karol Józef Wojtyła** in Wadowice, Poland, in 1920, he became the first non-Italian pope in over 450 years when elected in 1978. His papacy, which lasted more than 26 years, was marked by his deep spirituality, his emphasis on the dignity of every human person, and his tireless efforts to spread the Gospel across the globe. St. John Paul II played a crucial role in inspiring movements that helped bring an end to communism in Eastern Europe and was a strong advocate for peace, human rights, and the sanctity of life.

St. John Paul II was also known for his profound love of young people and his founding of **World Youth Day**, an international gathering that continues to bring millions of Catholics together in faith and joy. He was a man of prayer and great personal suffering, having endured the loss of his family at a young age and surviving an assassination attempt in 1981. Despite his physical struggles later in life, he remained a powerful witness of perseverance, forgiveness, and faith in God's mercy. His teachings, especially in encyclicals like *Evangelium Vitae* and *Redemptor Hominis*, continue to guide Catholics today in understanding human dignity and the call to holiness.

Catholics can celebrate his feast day by **attending Mass** and reflecting on his writings and teachings. Many parishes and schools hold special liturgies, talks, or youth gatherings in his honor, emphasizing his message of hope and the importance of a personal relationship with Christ. Reading excerpts from his encyclicals or his apostolic letter *Novo Millennio Ineunte* can be a meaningful way to deepen one's faith and renew commitment to prayer and service.

At home, Catholics might celebrate St. John Paul II's feast by **praying the Rosary**, which he loved deeply, or by meditating on his favorite prayer, the *Divine Mercy Chaplet*, which he helped promote worldwide. Families can also learn about his life by watching documentaries or reading his autobiography, *Gift and Mystery*. In the spirit of his example, doing an act of kindness, reaching out to someone in need, or forgiving an old hurt are simple yet powerful ways to honor this saint who taught that love and mercy are the heart of the Christian life.

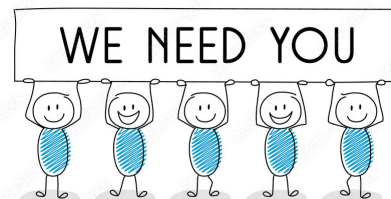
