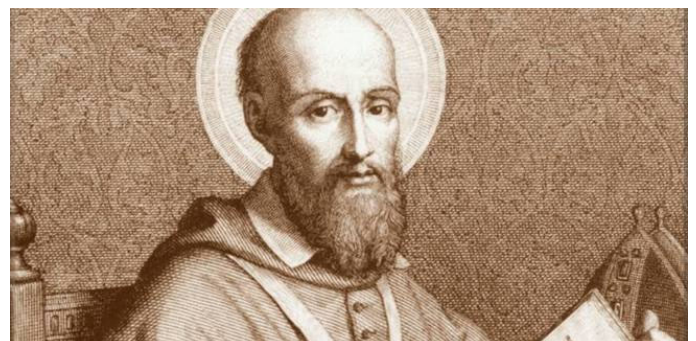

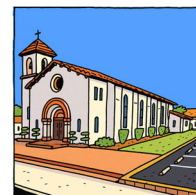

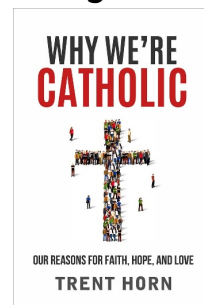

This Week's Featured Feast Day



St. Francis de Sales

Feast Day: January 24

St. Francis de Sales was born in 1567 in the Duchy of Savoy, in what is now France, and from an early age showed a deep love for God and learning. Though his father hoped he would pursue a political or legal career, Francis felt a strong call to the priesthood. He studied law and theology in Paris and Padua, becoming highly educated and spiritually grounded. After much discernment and resistance from his family, he was ordained a priest in 1593, dedicating his life to gentle evangelization and pastoral care.

One of the greatest challenges of St. Francis de Sales' ministry came when he was sent to the Chablais region, where many people had left the Catholic faith. Rather than using harsh arguments or force, Francis patiently preached, wrote pamphlets, and engaged people with kindness and reason. His calm spirit, humility, and perseverance gradually led many back to the Church. This missionary work revealed his core belief that hearts are won through love, not pressure—a principle that would define his legacy.

St. Francis de Sales is especially remembered for his spiritual writings, most notably *Introduction to the Devout Life* and *Treatise on the Love of God*. These works emphasized that holiness is not reserved for clergy or religious, but is attainable for everyone in daily life. He encouraged ordinary people—parents, workers, and professionals—to grow in virtue through small acts of love, patience, and faithfulness. Because of his clear, accessible writing style, he was later named the patron saint of writers and journalists.

As Bishop of Geneva, St. Francis de Sales was known for his compassionate leadership and close attention to his flock. He worked tirelessly to reform clergy, promote education, and guide souls with gentleness rather than severity. Together with St. Jane Frances de Chantal, he founded the Visitation Order, which emphasized humility, charity, and trust in God. His approach to spiritual direction was rooted in encouragement, making people feel loved and capable of holiness.

Catholics celebrate the feast day of St. Francis de Sales on January 24 by reflecting on his message of gentle holiness. One meaningful way to honor him is by practicing kindness in speech and resisting anger or impatience, especially in difficult conversations. Reading a passage from *Introduction to the Devout Life* can help deepen one's spiritual life. Catholics may also pray for writers, journalists, and communicators, asking St. Francis de Sales to guide their words toward truth and charity. Above all, his feast day invites believers to seek sanctity through love in the ordinary moments of life.

Notice of Deadline for Filing Claims: **February 2, 2026**

**YOU MAY HAVE A SEXUAL ABUSE CLAIM OR OTHER CLAIM
AGAINST THE ROMAN CATHOLIC BISHOP OF FRESNO**

On July 1, 2025, The Roman Catholic Bishop of Fresno aka the Diocese of Fresno filed a chapter 11 bankruptcy petition for protection under title 11 of the United States Code.

If you were sexually abused by any person connected with the Diocese, you must file a claim so as to be received by February 2, 2026, or otherwise you will be forever barred, estopped, and enjoined from asserting such claim against the Diocese.

Claims based on acts or omissions of the Diocese that occurred before July 1, 2025, must be filed on or before February 2, 2026, even if such claims are not now fixed, liquidated, or uncertain or did not mature or become fixed, liquidated, or certain before July 1, 2025.

Receiving the Sacraments

Anointing of the Sick: This Sacrament of Healing is available to baptized Catholics who are seriously ill, facing major surgery or near death. Call the Parish Office to schedule.

Confession: Confessions are held every Friday in the New Church starting at 5pm. You may also call the parish office to schedule an individual confession with Father.

Baptism: Parental participation in a program to prepare parents & godparents is required. Contact the Parish Office at least three months in advance of your desired baptismal date to make the proper arrangements.

Marriage: Couples are asked not to set a date for their wedding until an initial meeting with the Pastor. Diocesan requirements mandate a minimum six-month period of preparation. Marriage classes (5 classes per session) are scheduled 3 times per year as needed. Contact – Armel & Odelta Cardoso
